Establishment of Mini Poultry Feed Mill Under State plan during the year 2023-24

BACKGROUND

Odisha ranks 11th in Chicken meat production in the country with a total production of 109.74 TMT per annum. There are about 15000 broiler farms with capacity ranging from one thousand to one lakh, making the state self-sufficient in broiler meat production. The demand for taking up broiler farming as a viable income generating activity is becoming popular due to quick returns and shorter generation cycle. Currently, under the state plan scheme establishment of broiler units with 500 and 1000 bird capacity are being taken up throughout the state both on individual and SHG mode. The demand for quality poultry feed is huge at the local level as the cost of feed contributes 75 to 80% of total production cost. Hence, to minimize the production cost, to provide balanced complete feed and to make the poultry units economic, establishment of feed mills are ultimate options.

A Mini Poultry feed mill is a small manufacturing plant having production facility to prepare starters mash, grower mash, finisher mash, layer mash and to supply food products for chicken, geese, ducks and some of the domestic birds. It includes all the feed manufacturing processes or combination of processes used to produce and improve the quality of feed. The processing is usually divided into following steps: receiving and cleaning of raw materials, crushing of raw materials, batching, mixing, pelleting and packaging. The diameter of the final feed pellets can be 2 to 8 mm. After processing the feed become more digestible, palatable and helpful to increase the productivity of birds.

AIM:

This scheme aims to support establishment of 100 nos. of mini poultry feed mill.

2. OBJECTIVES:

- To establish portable mini poultry feed mills of capacity 50 Kg per hour at individual level.
- To address the problem of getting quality poultry feed at a cheaper price in rural level for establishing small poultry units.
- To provide income generating opportunity in rural area.
- To encourage farmers and unemployed youth of rural areas in to income generation through establishment of mini poultry feed mill units.

3. TARGET BENEFICIARIES:

Under the scheme, 100 individual beneficiaries will be covered.

4. SUBSIDY OUTLAY

5. SELECTION PROCESS OF FARMER

- Individual beneficiary will be eligible to avail support under the scheme. While availing subsidy, beneficiary family will be considered instead of individual member of family. One beneficiary family should not be provided with multiple benefits under one particular scheme. A family will not be eligible for subsidy under the same scheme if any of its members has got subsidy during last three years. However, if any member of one family gets the benefit as a member of WSHG, then other family members can avail any other scheme, as in a Group activity the profit for each of the group members may not be high.
- The individual beneficiary belonging to General category, SC, ST, Women,
 Transgender and Differently Able (min 40% disability) category will be provided with 40% back ended subsidy of the unit cost i.e of Rs 1.12 lakh per unit.
- The certificate of identity as transgender persons issued by District Magistrate as per 'The Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act, 2019" will be accepted for Transgender category.
- For differently able persons the certificate if disability issued by certifying authority
 / competent authority indicating 40% or more disability as per "The Rights of Persons with Disability Acts, 2016" will be accepted.
- The back ended subsidy will be released back ended in two phases through DBT mode to the individual beneficiary bank account as mentioned in the Subsidy Outlay: 4.
- In order to encourage better take off for Mini Poultry Feed Mill, the beneficiaries of bigger poultry units can also avail this scheme as an integrated unit.

6. Modalities of implementation for individual farmers

- The beneficiary belonging to General category, SC, ST, Women, Transgender and Differently Able (min 40% disability) category will be provided with 40% back ended subsidy of the unit cost i.e of Rs 1.12 lakh per unit and the remaining funds will be arranged by beneficiary either through bank loan or own sources.
- Each individual farmers will apply online in the Go-Sugam portal i.e https://sugam.odisha.gov.in as prescribed to the respective Block Veterinary Officer (BVO) or may contact with AVAS/VAS/BVO of respective block for assistance to apply.
- The selection of beneficiary shall be made in a transparent manner by the BLIT/CDVOs. Identification of beneficiaries must be made with Aadhar linking at the time of submission of application.
- The BVO shall compile the Block wise applications and thereafter undertake a joint verification in transparent manner of the proposed feed mill unit. The Block Level Inspection Team shall comprise of the following members.

a. BVO/AVAS/VAS

- b. Concerned Livestock Inspector/ VT/SVAS
- The block level inspection team will take geo tagged photographs (minimum 4 photos) from all angles of the site at the time of initial inspection. The team has to ensure that the proposal is a new project.
- On recommendation by the Block Level Inspection Team, as per Annexure- I, the respective BVO shall forward the applications for establishment of feed mill unit to the CDVOs.
- On receipt of e-applications by the CDVO, a District Level Committee
 comprising of Chief Development Officer-cum-Executive Officer,
 Zilla Parisad, CDVO, ADVO (LP), District Project Coordinator,
 Mission Shakti, District Project Manager, OLM and Project
 Administrator, ITDA (Concerned area) under the Chairmanship of the
 Collector & District Magistrate shall approve the final list of
 beneficiaries of the District.
- After approval of the list, Go ahead letter to the eligible individual will be issued by the concerned CDVO in the format enclosed at Annexure-II.
- The L.Is/ PraniMitras/ Gomitras will be tied up for providing handholding

- After issue of go-ahead letter, the individual beneficiary will construct the feed mill building and other infrastructure.
- Thereafter, the block level Inspection Team will inspect the completed building within 2 weeks period from the date of intimation by the beneficiary as in Annexure-III. They will take a geo-tagged photograph of the constructed feed mill building.
- The BVO will submit the completion report of the construction of building for establishment of feed mill enclosing the Geo tagged photograph and recommend to the concerned CDVO in Annexure- IV, for release of 1st installment of eligible subsidy.
- Thereafter, the beneficiary will procure plant & machinery from reputed source and install then.
- After completion of installation of plants and machinery, the individual will
 intimate local AVAS/BVO in the format enclosed at Annexure-III. The
 original GST bills for the machinery and equipment shall be submitted by
 the beneficiary to the BVO for claiming the subsidy.
- Thereafter, the block level Inspection Team will inspect the feed mill unit.
 They will take a geo-tagged photograph of the unit with installation of the plant and machinery and the BVO will recommend to the concerned CDVO in Annexure- IV for release of 2nd installment i.e. 60% of the eligible subsidy.
- The CDVO concerned will submit a monthly report on the implementation of the scheme to the Directorate of AH &VS, Odisha through the online Go-SUGAM portal.
- The list of beneficiaries' details will be uploaded by the CDVO in the Go-SUGAM portal.
- The Director AH&VS can revise the district wise targets as per the demand and progress of implementation.
- The district wise indicative target of beneficiaries to be covered is shown in Annexure-V.
- Administrative Cost will be given to CDVOs to meet the expenditure incurred towards monitoring & supervision of the scheme.
- The selected beneficiary to start the work at least within 2 months of issue of Go ahead letter. In case of failure to do so, a formal notice must be served to initiate the work within 15 days failing of which the go ahead issued will be canceled and issued to an eligible beneficiary either new / in the waiting list approved by the DLC.

- The applications of eligible and willing farmers who have already applied for establishing units under similar scheme in Go- Sugam for the year 2022-23 and are under wait list shall be considered for the financial year 2023-24 on priority. For the applications (for the year 2022-23) the concerned block and district officers are to verify the documents properly, obtain his/ her consent for placing in the DLC for approval and issue of Go- ahead letter.
- The targets shouldn't be a constraint for any district. The district official can enhance it up to 25% of their allocated target taking into account the potential & requirement of the district. The letter bearing No. 2620 dated 24.02.2023 issued from F&ARD Department may be referred for this purpose. The district officials are free to reallocate block targets according to the demand in different blocks.

8. SCHEME OUTLAY

The unit cost of one portable feed mill unit is Rs 2.80 lakh. The total expenditure for establishing 100 feed mill units under state plan with subsidy and administrative cost during the year 2023-24 is **Rs. 160.0 Lakh**.

One feed plant will be tied up with 4 broiler units (1000 capacity) set up by Individual beneficiary in the nearby area and the total requirement has been estimated at 70 metric ton per annum.

11. MONITORING AND SUPERVISION

- Regular supervision of the progress of the scheme will be done by the Directorate
 of AH & VS. The scheme will be reviewed by the Directorate of AH & VS on a
 fortnightly basis.
- Proper documentation will be done by taking geo tagged photographs of each feed mill unit along with individual beneficiary.
- Regular monitoring will be done by the SDVO Concern along with ADVO LP under the direct supervision of the CDVO.
- All data with regard to the scheme should be entered online on the Go-SUGAM portal at Block and district level.
- The monthly progress report will be submitted by CDVO every month in the online Go-Sugam portal.
- For effective implementation of the scheme the following monitoring mechanism
 has been suggested. The officers concerned will verify the mentioned percentage
 of schemes under their respective jurisdiction.
 - BVO 20% of the block target
 - Concerned SDVO 20 % of sub divisional target
 - ADVO (LP) 10 % of district target
 - o CDVO-5 % of district target
 - Concerned Scheme Officer of Directorate- 0.5% of State target
 - Concerned Additional Director 0.5% of State target
