The willing farmers/ entrepreneurs /ST, SC, Women, Transgender & Differently Able (min 40 % disability) beneficiaries will be eligible to avail support . 2. The certificate of identity as transgender persons issued by District Magistrate as per 'The Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act, 2019" will be accepted for Transgender category. 3. 5. All beneficiaries covered under the scheme should be Aadhar linked to avoid duplication.
6. **While availing subsidy, beneficiary family will be considered instead of individual member of family. One beneficiary family should not be provided with multiple benefits under one particular scheme. A family will not be eligible for subsidy under the same scheme if any of its members has got subsidy during last three years.** However, if any member of one family gets the benefit as a member of WSHG, then the other family member can avail any other scheme as in a group activity profit for each of the group members may not be enough.
7. The BVO shall compile the Block wise applications and thereafter undertake a joint verification in transparent manner of the proposed feed mill. The Block Level Inspection Team shall comprise of the following members
 1. BVO/AVAS /VAS/ MVU VAS
 2. Concerned Livestock Inspector/LT/ LEO

Verification will be made by any veterinarian as allotted by the concerned BVO, but signature of verifying Vet of the concerned VD & concerned BVO is mandatory.

The block level inspection team will take geo tagged photographs (minimum 4 photos from all angles of the site & 1 photo with all members from middle) of the site at the time of initial inspection. The team has to ensure that the proposal is a new project & also mention whether the individuals are optioned for shed or not. **Annexure-I.**

8. On recommendation by the Block Level Inspection Team, the respective BVO shall **forward the online applications of individuals to the CDVO.**

9. **On receipt of e-applications by the CDVO, a District Level Committee comprising of Chief Development Officer-cum-Executive Officer, Zilla Parisad, CDVO, ADVO (LP), ADVO AW, District Project Coordinator, Mission Shakti, District Project Manager, OLM and Project Administrator, ITDA (Concerned area), Chief District Agriculture Officer, Executive Eng Agri / Asst. Ex Eng. under**

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		<p>the Chairmanship of the Collector & District Magistrate shall approve the final list of beneficiaries of the district. More applications may be approved in DLC so that in case of any denial, the other applicants in queue may be issued go-ahead.</p> <p>10. After approval of the list, Go-ahead letter to the eligible farmers will be issued by the concerned CDVO as per Annexure- II.</p> <p>11. Then Go ahead will be issued by concerned CDVO.</p> <p>12. A beneficiary can apply under the scheme either opting for shed construction or without shed construction component.</p> <p>13. The applicants opted for "No shed", land details are not mandatory. The applicant opted for "Shed", land patta/ ownership details / land Lease documents are mandatory.</p>	
8	Implementation strategy	<p>(If opted for shed)-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. After issue of go-ahead letter, the farmer will construct the Mini poultry feed mill unit and other infrastructure. 2. After completion of the Mini poultry feed mill unit the beneficiary will intimate the Local BVO/ AVAS in the format enclosed at Annexure-III. 3. The block level Inspection Team will inspect the Mini poultry feed mill unit within 2weeks period from the date of intimation by the beneficiary. They will take geo-tagged photographs of the Mini poultry feed mill unit along with the beneficiary. 4. The Inspection Team will upload & submit the geo-tagged photographs of the Mini poultry feed mill unit and recommend to the concerned CDVO for release of 1st phase subsidy I,e 40% of the eligible subsidy in the format enclosed at Annexure-IV. 5. Then the beneficiary will procure plant & machinery from reputed source and install it in the building. 6. After completion of installation of plants and machinery, the beneficiary will intimate local AVAS/ BVO in the format enclosed at Annexure-III. 7. Thereafter, the block level Inspection Team will inspect the feed mill unit. They will take geo-tagged photographs of the unit with installation of the plant and machinery and recommend to the concerned CDVO for release of the 2nd phase subsidy i.e 60% 	

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of the eligible subsidy. **Annexure-IV.**

8. The individual members belonging to SC, ST, Women, Transgender & PWD (min. 40% disability) will be provided a maximum of 60% subsidy and individual belonging to General male will be provided a maximum of 50% back ended subsidy of the unit cost.
9. The eligible subsidy amount shall be released back ended to the bank account of the individual farmers through DBT mode only **through Unified payment layer system (UPL)** in two phases i.e.40% of the eligible subsidy after construction of the Mini poultry feed mill unit in the 1st phase and 60% of the eligible subsidy after completion of installation of plants and machinery in the 2nd phase with due asset verification by the inspection team.

If not opted for shed -

- After issue of the go-ahead letter, **then individuals** will procure plant & machinery from reputed source and install it in the building within 1 month of issue of go-ahead letter.
- After completion of installation of plants and machinery, the beneficiary will intimate local AVAS/ BVO in the format enclosed at **Annexure-III.**
- Thereafter, the block level Inspection Team will inspect and take geo-tagged photographs of the installation of the plant and machinery and recommend to the concerned CDVO for release of the eligible subsidy. **Annexure-IV.**
- The eligible subsidy amount shall be released back ended to the bank account of the individual farmers **through DBT mode by Unified payment layer System (UPL)** in Go-sugam portal only in single phase as mentioned in the **subsidy provision** with due asset verification by the inspection team.
- The individual members belonging to SC, ST, Women, Transgender & PWD (min. 40% disability) will be provided a maximum of 60% and individual belonging to General male will be provided a maximum of 50% back ended subsidy **of the recurring cost as mentioned in the subsidy provision.**

1. No additional manpower or Consultants shall be

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		<p>engaged for implementation of the scheme. This scheme shall be implemented with existing field staff.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. The individuals will fix the sign board on the details of the scheme. (Scheme name, year of implementation, beneficiary name and address, cost of the project, unit size, unit cost, subsidy etc. 3. Beneficiary can use own land or land on lease basis. 4. The district wise indicative target is shown at Annexure –V. The Director AH&VS may revise the district wise target as per the demand and progress of implementation. 5. The selected individuals to start the construction work at least within 2 months of issue of Go-ahead letter (if optioned for shed). In case of failure to do so, a formal notice must be served to initiate the work within 15 days failing of which the go ahead issued will be cancelled and issued to another eligible individual either new / in the waiting list approved by the DLC. 6. The applications of eligible and willing farmers who have already applied for establishing units under similar scheme in Go- Sugam for the year 2025-26 and are under waiting list shall be considered for the financial year 2026-27 on priority. For the applications (for the year 2025-26) the concerned block and district officers are to contact with the beneficiaries and obtain his/her consent to establish the unit for the yr. 2026-27 so that application can be placed in the DLC for approval and issue of Go-ahead letter. 7. The L.I.s/PraniMitras/ Gomitras/ other such workers will be tied up for providing handholding support to the farmers. 8. Administrative Cost will be given to CDVOs to meet the expenditure incurred towards monitoring & supervision of the scheme. 9. CDVOs in consultation with Lead District Manager of the concerned district shall take steps for arranging bank loan to the farmers for successful implementation of the scheme as per the requirement of the individual.

- I shall continue the Mini Poultry Feed Mill unit established under the State Plan scheme for a minimum period of three (3) years from the date of unit establishment (asset verification date).
- I shall not sell, transfer, lease, or otherwise dispose of the feed mill unit (including machinery and infrastructure) for a minimum period of three (3) years from the date of establishment (asset verification date).
- I will ensure that the feed mill is operated and maintained properly, and that all machinery and equipment are kept in good working condition.
- I will ensure that only quality raw materials are used for the preparation of poultry feed, and that proper storage practices are followed to prevent contamination and spoilage.
- I will adhere to all prescribed standards and guidelines for feed production, including hygiene, safety, and quality control measures.
- I will utilize the financial assistance provided under the scheme solely for the intended purpose of feed production for poultry.
- I understand that in case of any violation of the scheme guidelines or failure to maintain the unit for the stipulated three (3) year period, the government may recover the subsidy amount and/or render me ineligible for future benefits under the Animal Resources Development (ARD) sector.
