The willing farmers/ entrepreneurs /ST, SC, Women, Transgender & Differently Able (min 40 % disability) beneficiaries will be eligible to avail support & can set up Layer farm of any capacity as per their own choice.</p> <p>2. The certificate of identity as transgender persons issued by District Magistrate as per 'The Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act, 2019" will be accepted for Transgender category.</p> <p>3. While availing subsidy, beneficiary family will be considered instead of individual member of family. One beneficiary family should not be provided with multiple benefits under one particular scheme. A family will not be eligible for subsidy under the same scheme if any of its members has got subsidy during last three years. However, if any member of one family gets the benefit as a member of WSHG, then the other family member can avail any other scheme as in a group activity profit for each of the group members may not be enough.</p> <p>7. The BVO shall compile the Block wise applications and thereafter undertake a joint verification in transparent manner of the proposed poultry unit. The Block Level Inspection Team shall comprise of the following members</p>



1. BVO/AVAS /VAS/ MVU VAS
2. Concerned Livestock Inspector/LT/ LEO

Verification will be made by any veterinarian as allotted by the concerned BVO, but signature of verifying Vet of the concerned VD & concerned BVO is mandatory.

Selection of WSHGs:

8. Interested WHGs can set up Layer farm of 1000 bird capacity/2000 bird capacity/3000 bird capacity/4000 bird capacity as per their own choice.

9. The willing WSHGs will apply online (<http://sugam.odisha.gov.in>) as prescribed, to the respective Block Veterinary Officer (BVO) or may contact with AVAS/VAS/BVO of respective block for assistance to apply.

10. **Those WSHG who have availed subsidies previously or in verge of getting subsidy in similar types of schemes of Govt. of India or State Government shall not be included under this scheme. If the individual member of WSHG has availed subsidy under this scheme as a member of WSHG in Group mode during 2023-24, 2024-25 & 2025-26 then she will not be eligible to take up the scheme individually.**

11. **Aadhar number of President & Secretary of the WSHGs covered under the scheme should be linked to avoid duplication. Joint field verification will be done by Block level Inspection Team (BVO/AVAS /VAS/ MVU VAS, Concerned LI/LT/ LEO, Block project co-ordinator Mission Shakti / Block project Manager Mission Shakti) as per list of WSHGs applied in Go sugam for selection of the eligible SHG.**

The block level inspection team will take geo tagged photographs (minimum 4 photos from all angles of the site & 1 photo with all members from middle) of the site at the time of initial inspection. The team has to ensure that the proposal is a new project & also mention whether the individuals are optioned for shed or not. **Annexure-I.**

12. **On recommendation by the Block Level Inspection Team, the respective BVO shall forward the online applications both for individuals & WSHGs to the CDVO.**

13. **DLC shall be made both for individuals & WSHGs online applications.**

14. **On receipt of e-applications by the CDVO, a District Level Committee comprising of Chief Development Officer-cum-Executive Officer, Zilla Parisad, CDVO, ADVO (LP), ADVO AW, District Project Coordinator, Mission Shakti, District Project Manager, OLM and Project Administrator,**

		<p>ITDA (Concerned area), Chief District Agriculture Officer, Executive Eng Agri / Asst. Ex Eng. under the Chairmanship of the Collector & District Magistrate shall approve the final list of beneficiaries of the district. More applications may be approved in DLC so that in case of any denial, the other applicants in queue may be issued go-ahead.</p> <p>15. After approval of the list, Go-ahead letter to the eligible farmers/WSHG's will be issued by the concerned CDVO as per Annexure- II.</p> <p>16. Then Go ahead will be issued by concerned CDVO.</p> <p>17. A beneficiary/WSHG's can apply under the scheme either opting for shed construction or without shed construction component.</p> <p>18. The applicants opted for "No shed", land details are not mandatory. The applicant opted for "Shed", land patta/ ownership details / Lease documents are mandatory.</p>	
8	Implementation strategy	<p>(If opted for shed)-</p> <p>1. After issue of go-ahead letter, the individual/WSHG will construct the poultry shed and other infrastructure like Construction of Disposal pit for waste disposal, carcass & litter disposal pit.</p> <p>2. After completion of the shed the beneficiary/ WSHG will intimate the Local BVO/ AVAS in the format enclosed at Annexure-III.</p> <p>3. The block level Inspection Team will inspect the poultry shed & Disposal pit for carcass & litter disposal pit within 2weeks period from the date of intimation by the beneficiary/WSHG. They will take geo-tagged photographs of entire unit along with the beneficiary/WSHG.</p> <p>4. The Inspection Team will upload & submit the geo-tagged photographs of entire unit and recommend to the concerned CDVO for release of 1st phase subsidy i.e 50% of the eligible subsidy Annexure-IV.</p> <p>5. Then the beneficiary/WSHG will start rearing the birds. After induction of pullets, the beneficiary will intimate local AVAS/ BVO in the format enclosed at Annexure-III.</p> <p>6. Thereafter, the block level Inspection Team will inspect the fully stocked poultry unit. They will take geo-tagged photographs of the Poultry Unit and recommend to the concerned CDVO for release of the 2nd phase subsidy i.e 50% of the eligible subsidy. Annexure-IV.</p> <p>7. The individual members belonging to SC, ST, Women,</p>

Transgender & PWD (min. 40% disability) & WSHG will be provided a maximum of 60% subsidy and individual belonging to General male will be provided a maximum of 50% back ended subsidy of the unit cost.

8. The eligible subsidy amount shall be released back ended to the bank account of the individual farmers/WSHG through DBT mode only **through Unified payment layer system (UPL)** in two phases i.e.50% of the eligible subsidy after construction of the Poultry shed & disposal pit in the 1st phase and 50% of the eligible subsidy after stocking of the unit in the 2nd phase with due asset verification by the inspection team.

If not opted for shed -

9. After issue of the go-ahead letter, **then individual/WSHG** will construct the **Disposal pit for carcass & litter disposal pit** under supervision and guidance of the Block Level Veterinary officer.

10. Then individual/WSHG will arrange the litter materials, feeders, drinkers etc. / cage required and then induct the pullets under supervision and guidance of the Block Level Veterinary officer within 1 month of issue of go-ahead letter.

11. Then the individual/WSHG will intimate local AVAS/ BVO in the format enclosed at **Annexure-III**.

12. Thereafter, the block level Inspection Team will inspect & will take geo-tagged photographs of the **Disposal pit for carcass & litter disposal pit** & stocking of birds and recommend to the concerned CDVO for release of the eligible subsidy. **Annexure-IV**.

13. The eligible subsidy amount shall be released back ended to the bank account of the individual farmers through DBT mode only **through Unified payment layer system (UPL)** in single phase as mentioned in the **subsidy provision** with due asset verification by the inspection team.

14. The individual members belonging to SC, ST, Women, Transgender & PWD (min. 40% disability) will be provided a maximum of 60% and individual belonging to General male will be provided a maximum of 50% back ended subsidy **of the recurring cost as mentioned in the subsidy provision**.

Strategy-

1. No additional manpower or Consultants shall be engaged for implementation of the scheme. This scheme shall be

implemented with existing field staff.

2. The WSHG or individuals will fix the sign board on the details of the scheme (Scheme name, year of implementation, beneficiary name and address, cost of the project, unit size, unit cost, subsidy etc. along with the logo of Mission Shakti).

3. WSHG / Beneficiary can use own land or land on lease basis.

4. Administrative Cost will be given to CDVOs to meet the expenditure incurred towards monitoring & supervision of the scheme.

5. The district wise indicative target is shown at **Annexure –V**. The Director AH&VS may revise the district wise target as per the demand and progress of implementation.

6. The selected WSHG/ individuals to start the construction work at least within 2 months of issue of Go-ahead letter (if optioned for shed). In case of failure to do so, a formal notice must be served to initiate the work within 15 days failing of which the go ahead issued will be cancelled and issued to another eligible WSHG / individual either new / in the waiting list approved by the DLC.

7. The applications of eligible and willing WSHGs/individuals who have already applied for establishing units under similar schemes for the year 2025-26 and are under waiting list shall be considered for the financial year 2026-27 on priority. For the application (for the year 2025-26) the concerned block and district officers are to verify the documents properly, obtain the WSHGs/individuals consent for placing in the DLC for approval and issue of Go- ahead letter.

8. The L.I.s/PraniMitras/ Gomitras/ other such workers will be tied up for providing handholding support to the farmers/WSHG.

9. Kalinga Brown/RIR/ Gramapriya/Pallishree/CARI Sonali/CARI Priya/BV -300 or any recognized layer breed birds of 14 weeks old sexed birds (pullets) will be procured directly by the beneficiaries / WSHGs from reputed sources and can be reared in deep litter / cage system. However, the beneficiary/WSHG is given all the rights to procure layer breed birds as per his/ her own choice. The BVOs and Livestock Inspectors should ensure that quality birds are procured by the beneficiaries.

10. The WSHG will provide land for the poultry unit. Affidavit regarding land ownership may not be insisted upon for WSHGs. The WSHG will record the land availability status in the proceedings of the meeting convened for the purpose and it should be maintained in the meeting register.

11. CDVOs in consultation with Lead District Manager of the concerned district shall take steps for arranging bank loan to the farmers for successful implementation of the scheme as per the requirement of the individual/WSHG.

12. The BVO will provide all technical guidance to the WSHGs or individual farmers for maintaining proper veterinary health care and immunization of the poultry birds.

13. Construction of two Disposal pits i.e one for litter material disposal & another for carcass disposal pit must be constructed by the beneficiary/WSHGs while construction of poultry shed. For bio-security measures construction of foot path shall be done before entry of poultry unit.

Regarding manure production for deep litter system, 35 laying birds can produce about 1 ton of deep litter fertilizer in one year. So, 1000 birds can produce about 28.5 tons of deep litter fertilizer per year.

Regarding manure production for caged laying hens, 1,000 layer birds typically generate approximately 22 to 25 tons (about 20,000–23,000 kg) of manure per year on a dry basis.

<p>Carcass disposal pit shall be constructed inside the farm campus with dimension of 35 cubic ft per 200 birds with fencing & sign board. Carcass disposal pit should be 2 meter deep and half filled with waste, then covered with lime within 50cm of the surface, before filling the rest of the pit with soil. On each occasion, when waste is added to the pit, a layer of 10 cm soil shall be added to cover the waste.</p>
