EoI for Empanelment of "Supplier for Dairy Animals" Suppliers for supply of milch cow/buffalo from outside the State for sub-schemes under Mukhyamantri Kamdhenu Yojana (MKY) / Mukhyamantri Krushi Udyoga Yojana (MKUY)

The Fisheries & ARD Department has launched the **Mukhyamantri Kamdhenu Yojana (MKY)** to accelerate the growth of the dairy sector in the State through the induction of high-genetic-potential dairy cows/buffaloes from outside Odisha, with the objective of enhancing the quality and productivity of the State's dairy animal population. The Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, Odisha, Cuttack invites Expression of Interest (EoI) from the intending Firms/ Organizations / Agencies / individuals for empanelment towards supply of high milk yielding cows/buffaloes from outside the state for animal induction by farmers under State Plan Scheme "Mukhyamantri Kamadhenu Yojana" and Mukhyamantri Krushi Udyoga Yojana (MKUY).

The details of the Expression of Interest (Non-transferable) as well as terms and conditions and information docket are available on the DAH & VS, Odisha website <https://odishaahvs.nic.in>. Interested parties are requested to download the required documents and submit their response to the undersigned at the above-mentioned address along with the cost of the EoI document of Rs. 2360/- (Rs.2000/- + 18% GST) in shape of Bank Draft drawn in favour of the Director, AH & VS payable at Cuttack.

The cost of EoI documents is compulsory and the bank draft should be enclosed in original along with the EoI documents. The cost paid for EoI documents is non-refundable.

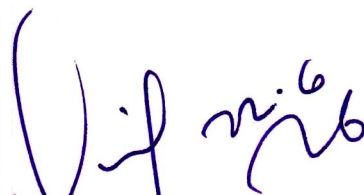

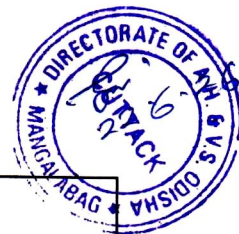

SCOPE & SPECIFICATIONS

Sl. No.	Description of cows/buffaloes to be procured	
1.	Breed	Holstein-Friesian Crossbred, Jersey Crossbred, Gir, Sahiwal, Graded Gir, Graded Sahiwal, Murrah She-buffalo, Graded Murrah She-Buffalo
2.	Sex	Female
3.	Lactation	Up to 3 rd lactation
4.	Milk Production Potential	Minimum 10 litres per day in case of cows Minimum 8 Litres per day in case of buffaloes
5.	General Health	Sound health without any deformities (Health Certificate from VCI registered Veterinarian)
6.	Vaccination Status	Must have been vaccinated against FMD & LSD (Must have a certificate from local veterinarian)
7.	Disease testing	Must have been tested negative for Brucellosis (Must have a certificate from local veterinarian)

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. It is preferable if animal procurement and inductions is carried out from native tract / well known procurement areas of the breed.
2. Induction of animals with 1st or 2nd lactation shall be preferred.
3. In case of recently calved milch cows, selection of such animals shall preferably be done within 2 months of calving so as to ensure date of calving.
4. All the animals should have been tagged from outside Odisha.
5. It is mandatory to procure animals from out of State & the animal must have registered in Bharat Pasudhan portal at least one year in that State before the date of induction. During this 1 yr., updation of any AH activities (AI, PD, progeny born, Vaccination etc.) must be done in Bharat Pasudhan portal.
6. Holding stations should be established by the supplier/agency, preferably district headquarters/ strategic locations for smooth access by farmers. The care & management of animals in the holding stations shall be in accordance with the rules & regulations of Animal Welfare.
7. The strategic locations for establishment of holding stations shall be finalised by the Directorate based on the availability and concentration of beneficiaries and the same shall be communicated to the selected supplier.



8. Geo-tag photos of all the inducted cows/buffaloes with detailed information such as breed, milk yield, tag nos. etc. should be furnished to the respective CDVOs when they reach the designated holding station.
9. The animals shall be housed at the designated Cow/ Buffalo holding stations, where centralized verification and processing activities such as assessment of health condition, verification of milk yield, breed of animal, tag number, uploading details to the Bharat Pashudhan Portal will be carried out.
10. All animals should have been tested for Brucellosis and vaccinated against Lumpy Skin Disease (LSD) and Foot & Mouth Disease (FMD).
11. The vaccination status shall be uploaded in Bharat Pashudhan portal as per applicability.
12. Necessary arrangements as per technical/ animal welfare requirement shall be made in holding farms where the animals would be kept in quarantine for 5 to 7 days before they could be procured by the beneficiaries.
13. The holding farms have to be kept vacant for at least 3-5 days before arrival of the next lot.

The empanelment of successful suppliers of milch cows/buffaloes for the purpose will be made through the bidding process which will remain valid for one year from the date of signing of agreement.

Submission of Bid

The bids are to be submitted offline.

Only those Bids that qualify in technical evaluation will be considered for empanelment.

Criteria for technical evaluation of eligible bidder:

1. Certificate of Registration of Firm under Society Act / Company Act or any other relevant Act in case of firms applying for empanelment.
2. The bidder must have a valid OGST Registration Certificate with up-to-date filing of returns.
3. Copy of PAN Card
4. Copy of IT Return for financial year FY 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25.
5. The bidder must have a minimum average annual turnover of Rs.1 Cr for the year 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25. He has to furnish the copy of average Annual Turnover Certificate issued by any Chartered Accountant for the year 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25. In case of individual the filed in IT returns/ solvency certificate of the same period needs to be submitted.



6. The bidders must have supplied cows/buffaloes to Govt. organizations/farmers under different livelihood schemes / outside scheme/ involvement in dairy development activities/ activities of dairy cooperative societies. He has to produce a credit invoice raised by the supplier/or certificate from the supplier agency/office indicating nos. of Cow/ Buffalo supplied / relevant documents for involvement in dairy development activities/ dairy cooperative activities duly signed by the competent authority.
7. Declaration in shape of an affidavit duly sworn in to the effect of the following-
 - a. that the firm/organisation has not been debarred /Black listed or derecognised by any State Govt. /Central Govt.
 - b. that the farm/organisation/bidders/suppliers must be able to supply a minimum 50 nos. of high yielding Cow/ Buffalo from outside the state per month (indicating the breed of cows/buffaloes to be supplied) with the maximum cost of @Rs 90,000/- per Cow/ Buffalo inclusive of transportation cost and transit insurance up to district level/selection point.
 - c. That the variety of Cow/ Buffalo supplied by him conform to the specifications and in the event of any dispute arising out of non-adherence to the specifications the decision of the CDVO of the concerned district will be binding.
8. The bidder shall furnish the bid document cost of Rs. 2360/- (Rs.2000/- + 18% GST) (Non-refundable) in form of Demand Draft.
9. Empanelment of the bidder shall be done after scrutiny of the documents submitted along with the bid.
10. The bidder should belong to the State of Odisha or have it's registered/branch office in Odisha. For that the bidder has to submit the rent agreement/electricity bill/phone bill/declaration in the form of an affidavit etc.
11. Bidders will be empanelled as per the Technical evaluation & scrutiny of the document by a committee to be constituted by Director, AH&VS.

Note: The Technical Bid will be opened on the scheduled date and time mentioned in the bid document. The bidders or their authorised persons are required to be present at the time of opening of bid.

The DAH & VS, Odisha reserves the right to modify, annul, change, delete any one or all conditions mentioned above without assigning any reason thereof and cancellation of the bid altogether.



Terms & Conditions

1. The registered / reputed bidders or suppliers/aggregators of high yielding Cow/ Buffalo / individuals may participate having experience (as per the criteria mentioned above) for supply of Cow/ Buffalo under Mukhyamantri Kamdhenu Yojana (MKY) & MKUY.
2. The CDVO of the concerned district will chalk out the tentative nos. of Cow/ Buffalo to be procured from the suppliers, block wise based on the no. of Go-aheads issued for the various sub-schemes under MKY. Accordingly the supplier may be informed about tentative prospects of animal procurement by beneficiaries.
3. The list of the empanelled bidder will be communicated with the allotted districts to which the bidder will supply cows & buffaloes as per the decision of the Technical Committee formed at the Directorate level which they (both empanelled bidders & districts) will abide & make arrangements for availability of animals at holding stations for choice by beneficiaries as per requirement of assigned districts. The CDVOs of districts may involve more than one supplier for such arrangements in case of delay in making provisions by an supplier.
4. The assigned bidder for the district(s) shall have to sign Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) in non-judicial stamp paper with the **Directorate of AH&VS** before supplying the Cow/ Buffalo.
5. If any bidder is not able to supply Cow/ Buffalo from outside the state or has supplied Cow/ Buffalo from within the state and/or untagged Cow/ Buffalo (as per information of CDVOs) as per requirement of the districts in the stipulated time period, then that bidder will be debarred for supplying animals further / in participating in any such related tender process in the next five years.
6. In case of non-supply of Cow/ Buffalo from outside the state or supplied Cow/ Buffalo from within the state and/or untagged Cow/ Buffalo by any bidder, the Director, AH&VS has the right to cancel the empanelment.
7. The cost price of Cow/ Buffalo includes the cost of tagging, vaccination, transit insurance, loading, unloading charges and transportation cost up to district level.
8. The bidder shall furnish the performance security of Rs 30,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Lakh) in shape of a Bank guarantee in favour of Director, AH&VS in the attached Annexure – IV.
9. Any legal dispute is subject to jurisdiction of Cuttack only.
10. During the process of evaluation if any bidder found guilty in providing false documents then he shall be debarred from participating in any such related tender process of DAH & VS, Odisha, Cuttack in future.
11. The successful bidders will start making availability of the animals for selection by beneficiaries within 2 months after being empanelled.



12. The bidder or his authorized person should attend the pre-bid meeting on dt.02.07.2026 at 11.30 AM at Directorate, AH & VS, Mangalabag, Cuttack. Any complaint or queries regarding contents of bid documents from any bidder will not be considered after pre bid meeting.
13. Payment will be made by the beneficiary to the supplier in on line mode after selection of the animals.
14. Self-attested documents / papers in support of all the components of eligibility criteria and terms & conditions shall be submitted.
15. The Director, AH&VS, Cuttack reserves the right to publish any corrigendum as regards to bid documents if so required before the last date of submission of bid.
16. The bid validity is up-to 180 days from the opening date of Technical Bid.
17. Bidder must sign at the bottom along with his seal in each page of the documents at the time of submission.
18. The power of attorney to sign the agreement on behalf of the bidder should be enclosed along with original documents.
19. **The last date of receipt of the bid is dt. 17.07.2026 till 05.00 PM. One sealed cover containing the technical bid superscripted as tender for empanelment of "Supplier for Dairy Animals" for supply of high yielding Cow/ Buffalo shall only be dropped in the specified box kept in the Directorate of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services at Purchase Section during office hours on working days.**
20. Applications received after stipulated date & time will not be entertained.
